Performance Measures

- Completeness & Consistency
 - 57% of agencies (155 agencies)
 - 76% of runs (9.2 million)

- Accuracy of Submissions
 - Avg. 93% validity score





Performance Measures

Timeliness of Submission

- Within 10 days 15%
- Within 30 days 47%

Integration

- 77% match rate with AHCA ER & InPatient



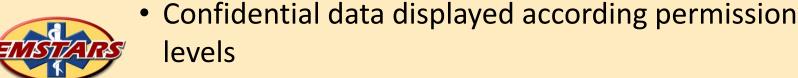


Reports

 - Same report on the dashboard at the home location
- Data Elements
 - Currently Empty
 - Review of element values in the system

- Currently Empty
- PCR Reports of each submission









Notifications

Standard

 This section logs notifications sent to agencies whether they are custom or from a template

Templates

 Allows for the creation of notification templates for reusability

Automated

 Automatic notifications such as friendly reminders that demographics are due







Requests

- NDR Requests
 - No Data Requests allow agencies to notify the state they have no data to submit for a particular month.
- Exception Requests
 - Allows for agencies to request a exception or reprieve from submitting data
 - The state can grant or deny the request

Records Exchange

- File Upload
 - Submit a file
- History
 - A history file submissions







Timeline?
