# The Business Rule Review

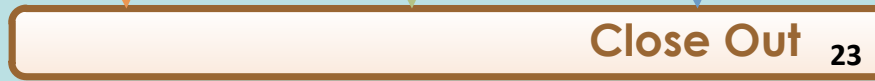
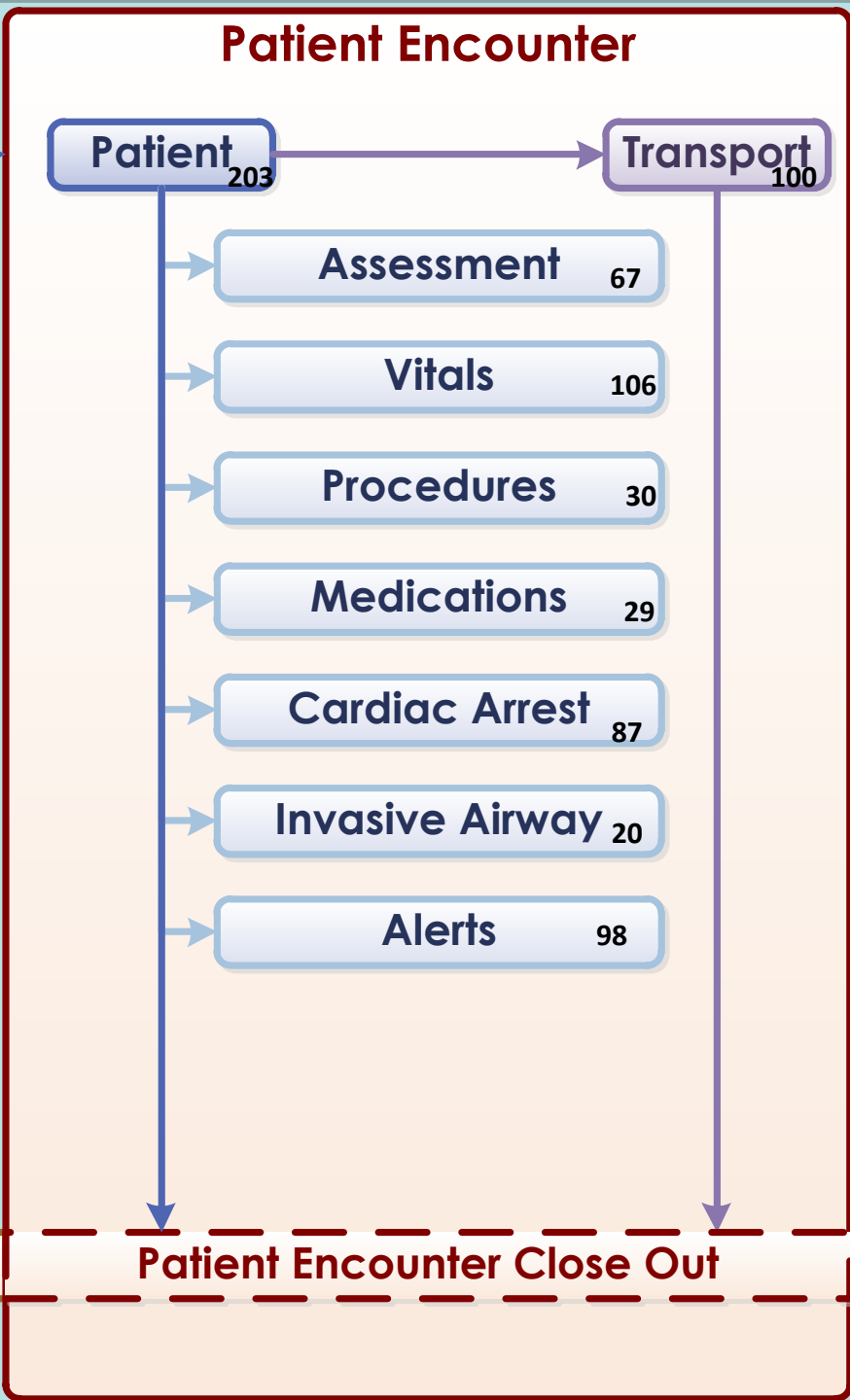
- Total of 877 Business Rules

- Need to include in EMSAC recommendation for Data Dictionary changes to incorporate V3.4 and revised business rules – (target submission 3/1/17 for April EMSAC mtg.)

- **Event-Enroute-Scene – 3 responses** only a few suggested revisions
- **Patient – 4 responses**, no suggested revisions
