The remaining 5 agencies are Version 1.4 and will be transitioning to Version 3 within the next two months. • Biospatial platform is providing a data management dashboard to provide agency level information as to submissions. Training has already been provided for this and additional session will occur 11/25/2020. • Biospatial will continue 3.4 and 3.5 compliance with NEMISIS.

- Initial use cases are listed below. Additional use cases will be included as it progress.
 - Incidents in which cardiac arrest patients who were discharged by the hospital alive that achieved return of spontaneous circulation during the EMS encounter.
 - Incidents in which stroke patients that were treated and transported by EMS to the hospital that originated in a 911 response have a matching hospital discharge record.
 - Incidents in which STEMI patients that were treated and transported by EMS to the hospital that originated in a 911 response have a matching hospital discharge record.

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<p>Update on Other Department Initiatives</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any topics for data committee to become involved with this coming year. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Coordinate data points for medical care committee. Biospatial repository will enable the ability to build in additional business rules to validate data. We may choose this year to build business rules around the strategic plan measures for more relevant data. ○ Universally unique identifier discussion. National trauma database will require UUID for trauma records from the trauma centers. Should add to the action list for recommendations which may include state issued ID bands of some kind. State office put together a list of what NEMSIS is already planning along this issue. ○ Vaccine administration discussion. First responders likely in initial groups to receive COVID-19 vaccine. Potential pinch point on registration process. Is there a method of connecting/batching data from employee files to upload to FL Shots so that entries can be completed quicker? Giving vaccinations by paramedics authorized by statute. County DOH responsible for data entry into FL Shots. Dr. Scheppke will bring up to appropriate state group to discuss and connect them with Ian Womack. 			

Open Discussion/New Business/Public Comment	<p>National NEWS</p> <p>EMS COVID Reporting Tool (available on NEMSIS website) - created by the NHTSA, Office of EMS to capture, in one place, PPE needs, personnel exposures and shortages in one unified reporting database. This will allow the NHTSA Office of EMS to present an accurate and current picture of the nation's EMS status at the federal level.</p> <p>The goal of the EMS COVID Resource Reporting Dashboard is to provide state/territory data managers and national partners with a current status of various types of PPE by EMS agencies. The dashboard is only available to authorized state/territory and national partners. Access requires an application and approval for an Active Directory (AD) account. Authorized state/territory users will be restricted to viewing only those reporting agencies from their state/territory. They will not be able to see data from other states/territories.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">••
